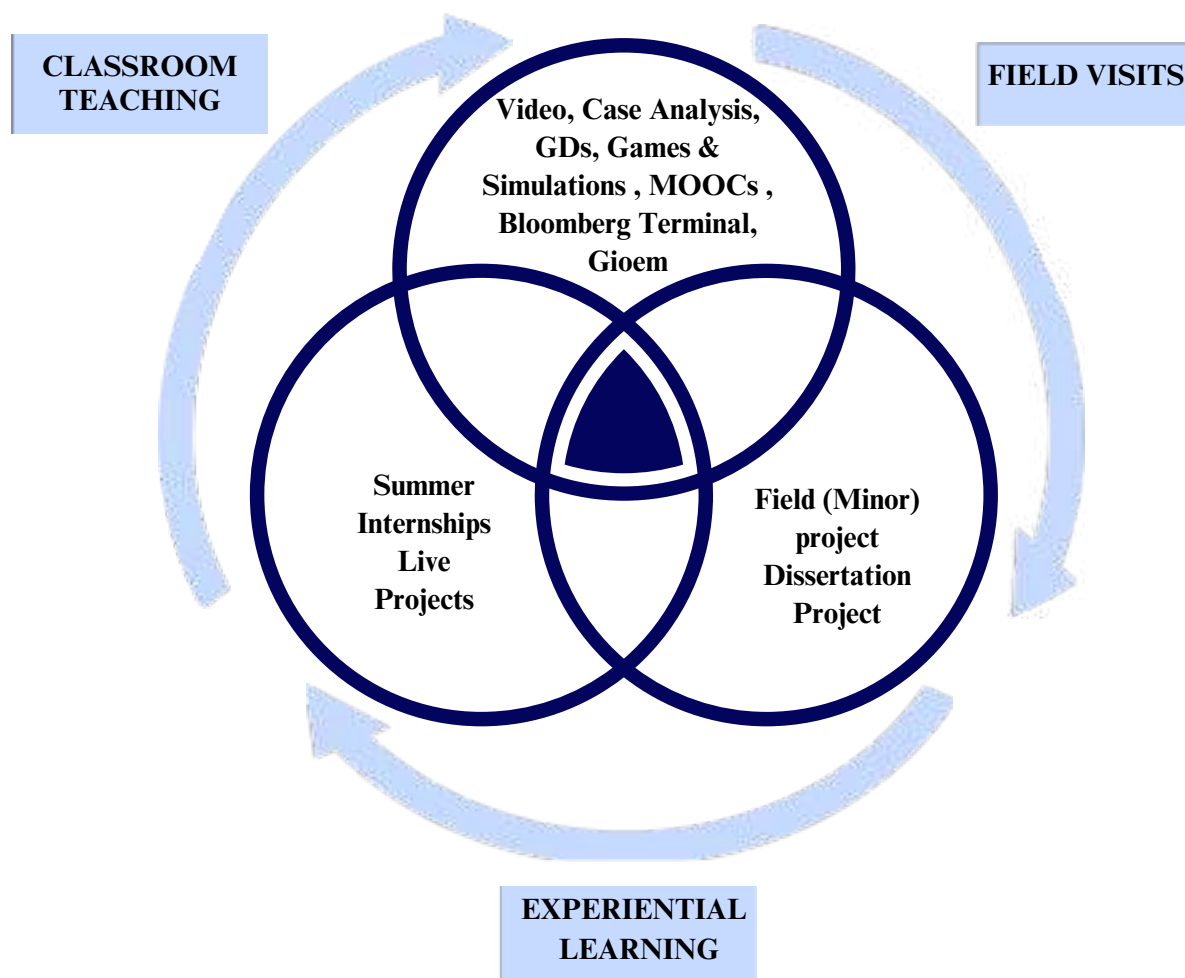


ERC

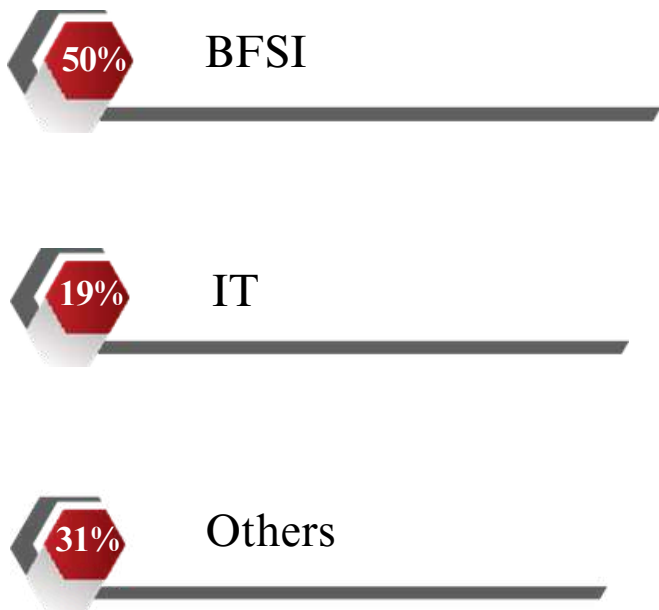

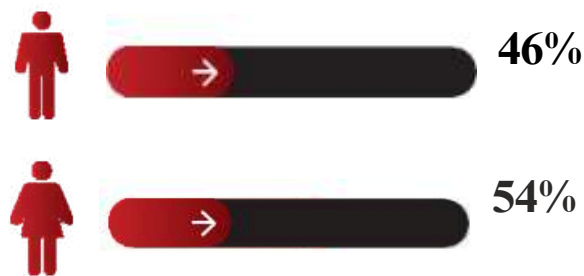

SECTOR WISE WORK EXPERIENCE



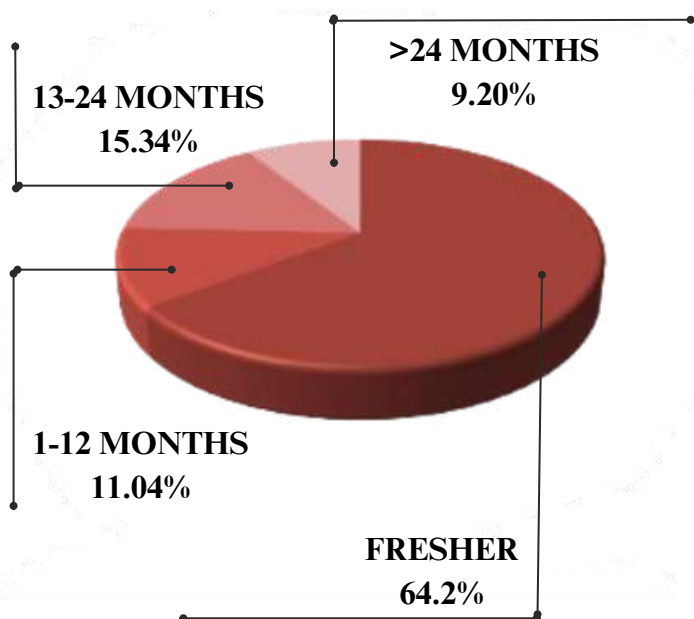

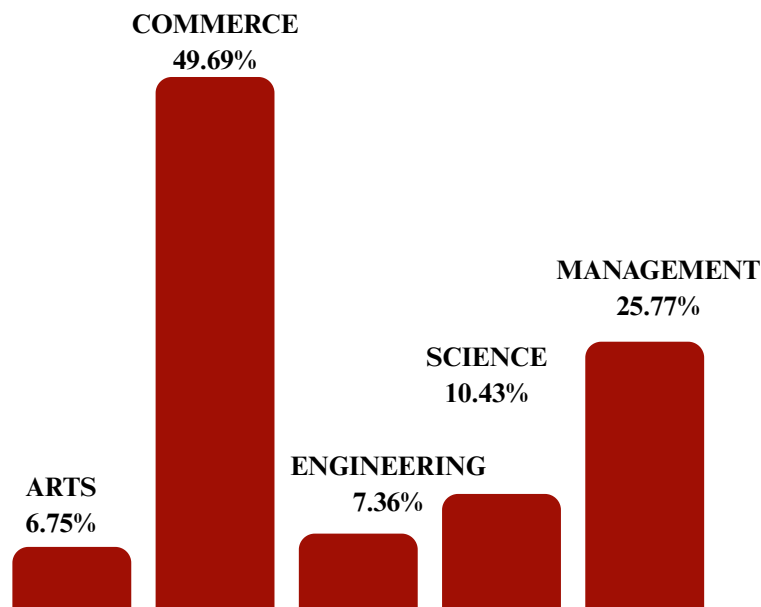
